

Import quarantine requirements of seeds of wheat, barley, oats, yellow peas intended for consuming and not for planting from Lithuania to Taiwan.

Seeds of *Triticum aestivum* (wheat), *Hordeum vulgare* (barley), *Avena sativa* (oats), and *Pisum sativum* (yellow peas) **intended for consuming and not for planting** from Lithuania must be free of soil and accompanied with a phytosanitary certificate issued by the National Plant Protection Organization (NPPO) of Lithuania when importing into Taiwan. The complete scientific name of the plant products (including genus name and species name), origin, and quantity needs to be stated on the phytosanitary certificate. Additional declaration is not required for the seeds intended for consuming and not for planting. The importer or its agent must apply for import inspection to BAPHIQ before the consignments arrive at the ports of entry. After completing the quarantine inspection, consignments of seeds mentioned above which are in compliance with our requirements and found free from pests will be allowed to be imported into Taiwan.
